

Sussex Safeguarding Adults Policy and Procedures: Updated Information-Sharing Chapter

Section 2.11. 'Adult safeguarding and sharing information' has been updated within the Sussex Safeguarding Adults Policy and Procedures.

As part of these changes we have:

- added new content around consent and information-sharing;
- reviewed and added additional links to our Sussex-wide protocols, such as the Information Sharing Protocol and the Sussex Safeguarding Thresholds Guidance;
- promoted the importance of robust multi-agency communication and working through forums such as Multi-Agency Risk Management (MARM) meetings in Sussex;
- introduced new content on the importance of ensuring effective communication and sharing of information when a person moves across geographical areas and the risk of abuse or neglect remains.
